Entry Requirements

- A Bachelor degree in any discipline or equivalent.
- Applicants holding other academic or professional qualifications and/or with five years relevant professional or management work experience in tourism may also be granted admission to the program following an evaluation of their academic and professional skills.
- An IELTS entry score of 6.0 or equivalent is required.
